The staff at Hydesville Elementary School District would like to begin by thanking all of our families for their understanding as we attempt to navigate the unprecedented pandemic situation we are currently facing. As a staff we have been hard at work preparing and have a plan that will begin to be implemented tomorrow, Wednesday the 18th.

Teachers have been hard at work creating high quality learning opportunities for all of our students. These are available in multiple formats, both online and in paper packets. Teachers have created Google Classrooms that they will be using with classes to post work, enrichments, videos, etc. (These resources can all be accessed online). We also recognize that some of our families may need these resources in a paper packet format. Paper packets will be available on a weekly basis for pick-up. Our first drive through pick-up event will be held on 3/18/2020, from 10am-12pm in the Hydesville Elementary School parking lot. Thank you very much for your understanding as we all navigate our way through this difficult time. We are working to utilize new tools for education, and there will be a learning curve. However, during this closure we feel it is important to offer our families and students materials to support learning at home. Once again, these learning activities are optional. Teachers are available via email, phone, and Zoom Virtual meetings during this time of closure.
