The following standards of ethical conduct are expected of all employees of Hydesville Elementary School District providing coaching services. All coaches shall abide by the following:

1. Show respect for players, parents, other coaches and staff.
2. Respect the integrity and judgment of the game officials.
3. Establish and model fair play, sportsmanship, and proper conduct during practices/contests and in the community.
4. Establish player safety and welfare as the highest priority. If there is any question as to the extent of an injury, a physician must be consulted, and a written release obtained.
5. Provide proper supervision of student-athletes while under the coach's direction.
6. Use discretion and proper language when providing constructive criticism to players – use of profanity is unacceptable.
7. Understand the proper administrative chain of command and refer all request or grievances in the following order:
 - 1st- Travis Victorine, Athletic Director
 - 2nd- August Deshais, Superintendent-Principal
8. Consistently require all players to adhere to the established rules and standards of the game.
9. Will include every player in every league game. Only during tournament play will players be selected at the coaches discretion to play based on grade level, participation, effort, and/or demonstrated skill.
10. Properly instruct player in the safe use and care of equipment and uniforms.
11. Assume full responsibility for the actions and behavior of all assistant team coaches.
12. Establish and maintain open communication with families prior to and during the season.

I have read and will adhere to the expectations of the Hydesville Elementary School District Coaches Code of Conduct and understand that failure to do so may result in suspension and/or dismissal from the position, which may limit the ability of student athletes to participate in league and tournament play.
