These same teachers who worked hard to navigate us through the end of last year. And I'm sure they worked just as hard, if not harder, working on plans for this years curriculums. Im saddened that the two teachers my kids have already experienced and currently have will not be continuing the year. Mrs. Riggs has already taught Calan and knows his needs. I have enormous faith in her abilities to continue through distance learning. And there's not a single kindergarten student to walk out of Ms. Rosser's class a brighter and more we'll rounded kid.

I think we are rushing this decision and adding too much pressure on the ones who are already the brunt of the pressure. We need them. We deserve them. And they deserve the time it needs.

I hope that I'm wrong, I sincerely hope you take this into consideration.

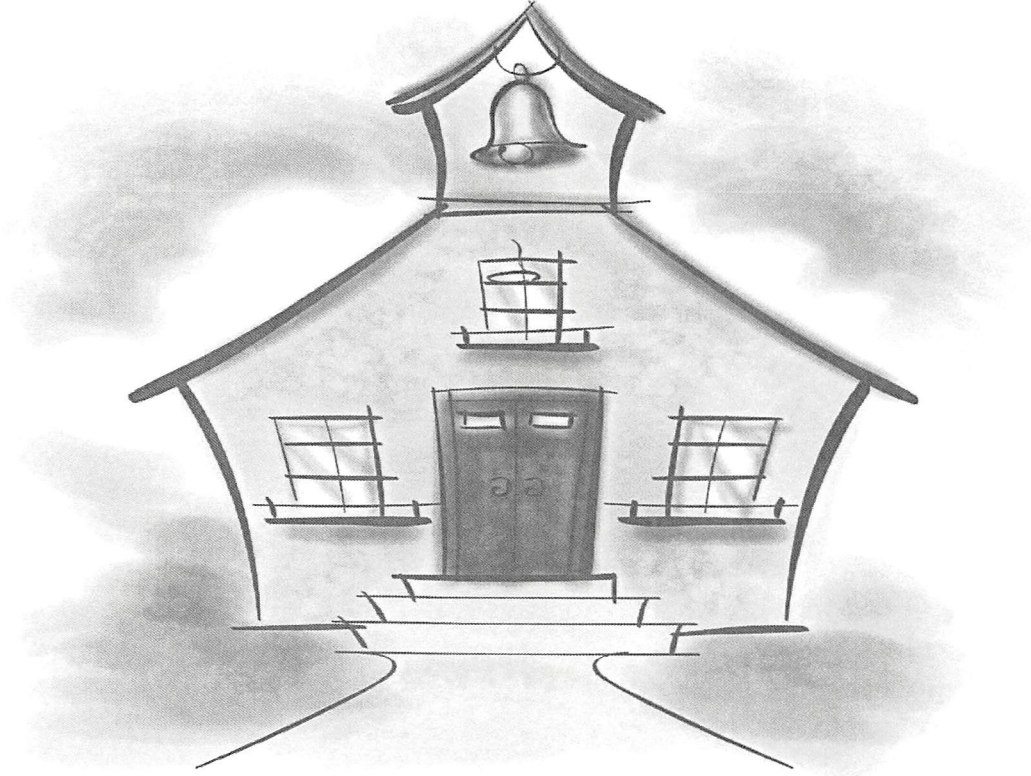

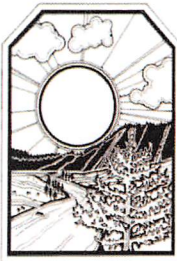

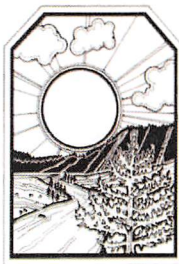
