Im saddened that the two teachers my kids have already experienced and currently have will not be continuing the year. Mrs. Riggs has already taught Calan and knows his needs. I have enormous faith in her abilities to continue through distance learning. And there's not a single kindergarten student to walk out of Ms. Rosser's class a brighter and more we'll rounded kid.
