Hydesville Elementary School District STUDENT DRESS CODE AND GROOMING STANDARDS

In cooperation with teachers, students and parents/guardians, the Superintendent/Principal or designee shall establish school rules for governing student dress and grooming which are consistent with law, Board of Trustees policy and administrative regulations. These school dress codes shall be regularly reviewed. (*AR* 5132(a))

The following guidelines apply to all regular school activities:

- 1. Shoes must be worn at all times. Sandals must have heel straps. Appropriate footwear is required for PE activities.
- 2. Clothing, jewelry, and personal items (such as backpacks, water bottles, etc.) shall be free of writing, pictures, or any other insignia which are crude, vulgar, profane, sexually suggestive, which bear drug, alcohol, or tobacco advertising, promotions, or which advocate racial, ethnic, religious, or any other form of prejudice.
- 3. Hats and caps must be removed when indoors.
- 4. Clothes shall be sufficient to conceal undergarments at all times. See-through fabrics, halter tops, off-the shoulder or low-cut tops, bare midriff and skirts and shorts shorter than mid-thigh are prohibited.
- 5. Coaches and teachers may impose more stringent dress requirements to accommodate certain sports and/or class activities.
- 6. Hair may not be sprayed with any coloring that may drip when wet.

Note: The Hydesville Elementary School District may alter these guidelines as needed to ensure safe and appropriate dress and grooming guidelines are in place at all times.
