Hydesville School Sports Teams Policy

Approved 10.13.16

Physical activity including competitive sports is an important component of a well-rounded education. Sports at its best, is an educational experience. Participants learn cooperation, discipline, dedication, and sportsmanship, in addition to basic skill development.

1. The School's priorities are Inclusion (no cuts), Sportsmanship, Skill Building and Winning, in that order.
2. The School will strive to maintain grade level participation as team numbers allow. Players will not play up out of grade if positions are not available. Play time is determined at the discretion of the coaches.
3. The Athletic Director, Superintendent/Principal and Coaching staff will consider other sports and the number of teams per sport as to their viability and budget allowance.
4. The School supports all teams to participation in two tournaments per season with the additional Crescent City Tournaments for 8th grade teams as determined by the Athletic Director and Coaching Staff and authorized by Superintendent/Principal.
5. The Board will review the sports budget annually to determine the level of District financial support.
